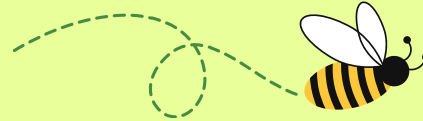

The aim of the Prince Philip Hospital Gardens Appeal is to raise £100,000 to create two new therapeutic gardens at the Hospital. The new gardens will be for:

- Mynydd Mawr ward, a 15-bed elderly care rehabilitation unit
- Bryngolau ward, a 15-bed older adult mental health unit.



The wards are located next door to each other on the ground floor of the hospital and have access to enclosed outdoor space. This space, however, is currently not in use and is not suitable for patients. The new gardens will support recovery and promote wellbeing by providing safe, joyful and healing spaces where our older patients can enjoy fresh air, exercise and feel close to nature. The gardens will also provide a restful environment for staff and visitors.
